Brief reflection from Sacred Space on today's gospel (Matthew 11:40-42)

In today's reading from Matthew's gospel, Jesus reproaches people who have witnessed his mighty deeds yet still lack belief. Jesus first prays in thanksgiving to God who has made himself known to Jesus' disciples. He praises God who has made himself known to the "little ones" and not to the wise and learned. As in other recent readings from Matthew's Gospel, a contrast is made here between the unbelieving Pharisees, who are wise and learned, and the faithful disciples, tax collectors, and sinners with whom Jesus keeps company.


In the concluding sentences of today's Gospel, Jesus' teaching is again contrasted to the teaching of the Pharisees. The careful observance of the Mosaic law taught by the Pharisees could be experienced by some as difficult and burdensome. In contrast, Jesus' way of holiness is presented as uncomplicated and even restful.

In essence, Jesus is saying, "If you seek God; if you seek his love; if you seek a life that makes some sense; if you want a way of understanding the world that allows you to deal honestly with what happens and not be destroyed; if you want to be who you are created to be – if you want this, then come to me."


