Reflection from Sacred Space on today's gospel reading (Mark 14.1-15. 27)

This is a day both of triumph and tragedy. There is the joy of Jesus entering Jerusalem and getting an enthusiastic welcome from the crowds. "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord." But the picture very soon changes to darkness, to suffering and death.

Our key to understanding this week is in today's Second Reading from Paul's letter to the Philippians. "Let the same mind be in you which was in Christ Jesus." Though Jesus was in the form of God, he "emptied" himself, and went down to the lowest depths of degradation and humiliation, dying naked and as a convicted criminal.

This is the measure of his love us, laying down his life for his friends, an expression of God's love for us. And, because of the intensity of the love he showed he is swept up into the glory of God. So that we, too, may follow. But, on the way, we also have to be ready to empty ourselves in love for him and to be totally at the service of our brothers and sisters.
