REFLECTION ON TODAY'S GOSPEL READING: Mark 3.20-35

The message is sent in: "Your mother and brothers and sisters are outside asking for you." To which Jesus replies, "Who are my mother and my brothers?" And pointing to those sitting at his feet listening to his teaching, he says, "Here are my mother and my brothers." And he clarifies that further by adding, "Anyone who does the will of God, that person is my brother and sister and mother."

We should note that Jesus' family is described twice as being on the "outside". They are "outsiders". By implication, those sitting in a circle with Jesus are on the "inside"; they are the "insiders".

What Jesus is clearly saying is that being on the "inside" is not just a question of location but of relationship. That relationship is not by blood but by identification with the Way of Jesus. To be a Christian is to enter into a new family, with stronger ties than those of blood and where everyone is seen as a brother of a sister. The "insider" is defined simply as "anyone who does the will of God". (www.sacredspace.ie)


