Please **DO NOT** come to church if you are unwell - Please use **hand sanitiser** provided - Please maintain **safe social distancing**.



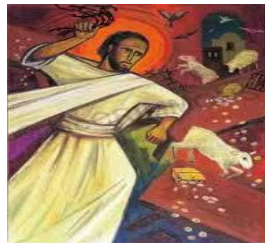
Reflection from Sacred Space on today's gospel reading (John 2.13-22)

The temple was the centre of Jewish life. It represented the location and the presence of God. Jesus is not against the temple but is against what the temple has become: a marketplace rather than a place to worship the Father. The Father who loves everybody equally and whose love could not be bought.

Jesus declares that a new Temple will be found in his own resurrected body. Instead of God's presence being confined to a single geographical site, God will be everywhere, making all things and all time potentially sacred.

We are the temple of God in the world', wrote St Paul. Have I really grasped this colossal reality that I am a living temple, in which the Word of God is eternally spoken?

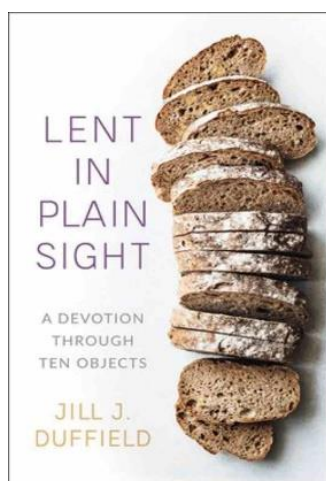
