Reflection from Sacred Space on today's Lectionary Readings

(John 1.6-8,19-28)

John the Baptist was a witness to the light. He could acknowledge the truth about himself and his role. He was a prophet and was in continuity with the prophets, but he was not the Messiah. John's mission was to introduce Jesus and help people be ready for and recognise Jesus. John worked in the wilderness and introduced a new era from there.

How does John help me to introduce Jesus in the wilderness of this time? He reminds me that I am called to be a witness to the true Light – Jesus. I ask the Lord to strengthen that sense of mission in my life and give me the grace to live it.


