Reflection from Sacred Space on today's gospel reading (Matthew 5:1-12)

Why read the Beatitudes on the Feast of All Saints? Because they get to the heart of holiness. They express the values to which Christians are called at their baptism. When we meet someone whose life expresses these values we recognise a saint. Note that the word Beatitudes means blessings. These are not commandments to be obeyed but blessings to be sought. The Beatitudes show me what is in the heart of Jesus, what he considered to be signs of God's kingdom. I pray that my eyes be blessed to recognise how the kingdom of God is around and about me

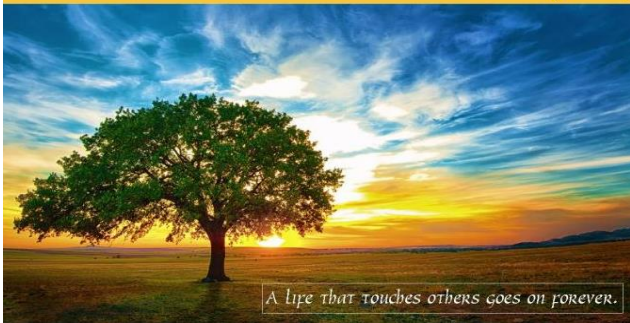
