Reflection from Sacred Space on today's Lectionary Readings

(Luke 1:26-38)

Mary, the young girl of no status, from the village of Nazareth, an utterly insignificant place is signalled out, called, chosen, and overshadowed with God's Spirit. Her response moves from one of fear to total trust in God's inscrutable designs.

God has something in mind for us to do; like Mary we are to bear good news to others, and the Holy Spirit will help us. God waits for our response.
