### Reflection on Today's gospel reading from Sacred Space (Mark 1:21-28)

Today's passage is the first part of a day in the life of Jesus in which he carries out the main activities of his mission – teaching and healing. He goes to Capernaum, and on a Sabbath day, like every observant Jew, goes to the synagogue. He begins to teach the people who are deeply impressed because, unlike the Scribes, he speaks with authority and he casts out unclean spirits.

Jesus' authority came from his person. There we see what it can mean to be fully human: compassionate, fearless, loving, with a passion for justice and awareness of what is in the human heart. It is by watching him and pondering his words and behaviour, that I too will learn what it is to be human.

## CROSSLINKS

The Crosslinks group was founded in 1981, the International Year of the Disabled, in response to a request made to Archbishop Peter Carnley. The group consists of people with intellectual disabilities, their families, friends, carers, members of the Anglican Parish of Floreat Park and other supportive people including members of the Friends of L'Arche, Perth, and welcomes Christians from various denominations.

The group was named Crosslinks to indicate our twofold role:

- to provide a place of meeting for worship and fellowship under the Cross of Christ; and
- to be a crossover for people with an intellectual disability into the life of the Diocese.

The group, led by the Crosslinks Chaplain Reverend Pat Deeny, and Crosslinks Deacon, Reverend Les Marshall meets on the third Sunday of the month at St Nicholas Anglican Parish of Floreat Park for a Holy Communion Service commencing at 5.30PM followed by a shared meal.

While the Parish of Floreat are happy to continue hosting this event, additional help is required to set up, serve the meal and clear up afterwards. I would be very grateful for three volunteers from St Christopher's every month to assist with this.
